



## **Price Report for February 21, 2022 M-15 General Consignment Online Auction**



A 1948 Indian Chief Roadmaster motorcycle in unrestored condition sold for **\$28,325** and was the highlight of over 4,000 lots in the February 21, 2022 weekly online consignment auction at [www.BidNow.us](http://www.BidNow.us). Bidnow is the online auction platform owned by Albrecht Auction Service, located in Vassar, MI. Buyers at this auction represented 7 different States, with the farthest item going all the way to Scotland! Prices in this report include the 10% buyer's premium.



Another highlight of the auction was a lot of (7) 1934 Goudey Gum Co. baseball cards which sold for **\$5,600** and included the rare #61 Lou Gehrig card! A lot of (31) 1909-1911 T206 baseball cards reached **\$1,015**. A 1933 Goudey Jack Dempsey #17 boxing card brought **\$440**. There were also contemporary ball cards which featured a 1984 Topps John Elway graded PSA 9 which sold for **\$405**.



Other items of interest included a rare "St. Kilda Mail Boat" which was a communication device, made of a 15"L wooden boat with a hollowed out compartment that would contain messages for help or food needed by the St. Kildan people that lived on a small island off of Scotland in the late 1800s to early 1900s.

The boat originally had an inflated sheep's bladder attached to a wood piece as a buoy that would help the boat make its journey to the mainland weeks or even months later. The bladder is now hard and flat but the unusual boat reached **\$1,023**. An interesting side note on this boat is that it was noticed by a Scottish Conservation Charity and then purchased on the auction to be put on display back in Scotland!



Another estate item that drew interest was a silver "Model of Movement" representing the sleeve motor of the "Argyll Car" used in the Cape to Cairo Auto Expedition through Africa in 1913. This piece came with documentation letters from the 1920s that this was originally presented to Princess Louise, Duchess of Argyll. The 4" h. silver piece sold for **\$660**.



You will always find a nice selection of jewelry and the show stopper in this auction was a 18K sapphire and diamond ring with sold for **\$2,800**.



Firearms are a popular selling item and the top (5) in this auction were as follows: Winchester Mod. 71 .348 WCF lever action with a side mounted scope **\$2,750**, Winchester Mod. 92 .25-20 lever action **\$1,660**, Winchester .375 big bore lever action **\$1,160**, Remington Mod. 788 .44 Mag with scope mounts **\$1,380**, and a Ruger No. 1 .450 Bushmaster **\$1,320**.
